

KWANZAA UNITY GARLANDS

Kwanzaa is not a religious holiday, but a celebration designed to honor the values of ancient African cultures and inspire African Americans. Kwanzaa is based on the year-end harvest festivals that have taken place throughout Africa for thousands of years. Kwanzaa lasts 7 days. Each day honors a different principle and symbol that is believed to be very important to developing strong and healthy families.

Celebrate Kwanzaa by stringing together a Unity Garland composed of Kwanzaa colors. Make your garland 7 loops long to honor the 7 days of Kwanzaa! Take your garland home or hang it on our Holiday Tree!

Directions: Use a strip of paper and bend it so the two ends are touching. Tape or glue the two ends together. Use another strip of paper and loop it through the first circle. Tape or glue the ends together. You should have two circles that connect to each other. Keep adding more loops to complete your garland.
