SERIES A. REPORT ON CUBA, 1964

This series is composed of a document entitled "A Report on Cuba, and Evalutions of the Exile Attack Situation to Date: Delivered to Buck Persons by Craig T. Sheldon of Fairhope, Ala." Dated 1964 July 23, the document is a history of Sheldon's involvement in the resistance movement against Fidel Castro's Communist regime in Cuba.

SERIES B. CORRESPONDENCE, 1962-1968

This series contains correspondence to and from Craig Sheldon and is concerned with a variety of topics. Correspondence documenting Sheldon's activities in Alpha 66 and the International Anti-Communist Brigade is in this series. The series also includes copies of letters from Sheldon that he wrote to publications and prominent people about the situation in Cuba and the U. S. response to Castro's regime. The series also includes letters from people responding to Sheldon's letters that appeared in newspapers and other publications. Other letters in this series include those from people interested in contributing money and their services to the resistance, as well as letters from people giving their opinions on events in Cuba, Vietnam, and other locations around the world. Much of the correspondence expresses frustration with the U. S. government. Of particular interest are letters written after John F. Kennedy was assassinated. Correspondents in this series include Dan Smoot, May Orrell, C. E. Whitehouse, Walter McNamara, William Loeb, Jim Buchanan, Claire A. Chennault, and Robert S. Allen. Arranged chronologically.

SERIES C. CLIPPINGS AND NEWSPAPERS, 1962-2012

This series is composed of clippings and newspapers that document the resistance movement; events in Cuba; Barry Goldwater's run for the presidency; and world events dealing with Communism. There are also clippings of editorials and letters to editors reflecting frustration with the U. S. administration for not being more decisive against Communist governments.
